The Royal Zoological Society of Scotland (RZSS) is a conservation organisation and charity which aims to have a positive impact on people, communities and the environment. Any person who visits, collaborates with, or is employed by RZSS will understand our continual commitment to minimising the negative and maximising the positive environmental impacts of our operations and prevention of pollution to safeguard the protection of the environment.
